

Mabema GPV to Södra and VIDA

The Linköping company Mabema AB received a longed-for Christmas present the day before Christmas eve when both Södra Skogsägarna Economic association and VIDA Alvesta AB each ordered one measuring system type Mabema GPV. Total order value is approx. 8 mill Sek and delivery is planned to summer/fall 2016 for both systems.

These two orders are the definitive breakthrough for Mabema and the company's own developed technique to automatically measure piles of wood on trucks. Since more than a year ago there is a commercial site in operation at the Holmen Paper site in Braviken, outside the city of Norrköping. This measuring frame has earlier also worked as a prototype and development site for almost five years.

The new GPVs will preliminary be placed at Södra Cell site in Värö and at Vida saw mill in Alvesta.

Naturally, every one working at Mabema is more than thrilled over the two orders which also gives us the means to continue improving our technique in to a more accurate and effective system.

The delivery to Södra and VIDA also includes a number of customer adaptations that will widen the range of service from the GPV focusing on length control, log detection, diameter allocation and rot/wreck assessment. New approvals on various wood assortment is also prioritized.

Mabema, who has additional quotations with major producers of P&P is looking forward to an exciting 2016 as the forest industry in Sweden finally takes the eagerly awaited technique jump against a more automatized wood measuring.
